- Water samples taken in February from Campground and Cassal systems were free from contamination.

- Answered many varied emails, and phone calls.
- Monitored booster pumps on weekends

Other Items

- Attended Board meeting on February 2, 2015.
- Processed owner's checks for 2015 dues and fees. Have received over \$180,000 to date (03-05-2015)
- Gave Jim Wright the go-ahead to proceed with the installation of the water line to Eagles Nest Road as soon as weather permits.
- Wrote a pro-forma about the possibility of turning off water service to homes whose owners are in arrears with their dues and fees payments. This will be discussed at the Board meeting in April.
- Attended the Evergreen Rural Water of Washington annual meeting in Yakima (Feb 17-19 in order to satisfy 1.5 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) for my drinking water certification requirements.
 - (- One of the sessions concerned the use of an internal pump to circulate the water in an above-ground tank. If this can be done with our 120,000 gal tank, it should prevent the possibility of water in the tank from freezing in the winter months, and may obviate the need to drain the tank during those months. I am investigating this.)
- Registered for the Washington Environmental Training Center, Washington Operator Workshop, March 23-25, in order to complete the CEUs needed for this time period (1/1/2013 12/31/2015).
