Recurring Items

- Water samples taken in March from Campground and Cassal systems were free from contamination.
- As always, processed and categorized invoices, scanned and emailed to Jim McDonald for final approval. Took originals to Bradshaw for payment.
- Processed owners checks and delivered to Bradshaw for deposit
- Answered many varied emails, and phone calls.
- Monitored booster pumps on weekends

Other Items

- Processed owner's checks for 2015 dues and fees. Have received over \$200,000 to date (03-31-2015)
- Attended the Washington (water) Operators Workshop in Lynnwood, WA in order to earn the balance of the CEUs necessary by December 31, 2015 for my drinking water certification requirements.
- Wrote a letter to each homeowner who will be receiving a new Sensus meter in 2015. The letters were in three categories - 1- those who require only a meter, 2- those who require a meter and a setter, and 3- those who require a new vault and meter.
- Attended a meeting concerning the taxes on a parcel of land that we have ceded for use by the Methow Conservancy. Made application for an additional reduction in taxes by requesting that the parcel be designated as open space.
- Began preparations for herbicide application on Edelweiss common areas.
